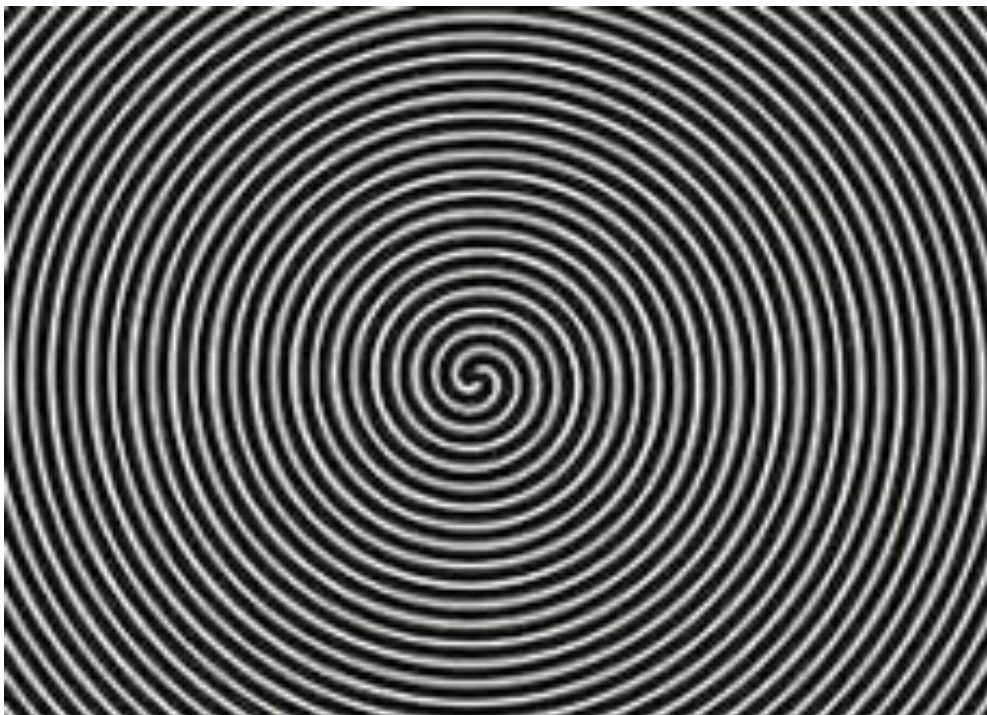

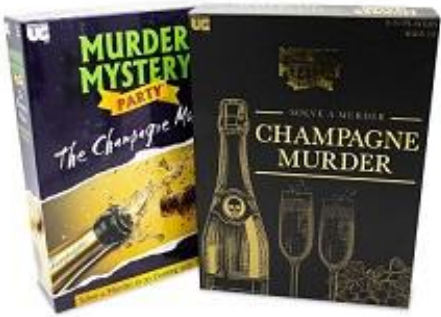

Silent Auction Bidding Procedure

To place your online bid

1. Go to this web address: <http://togetherauction.com/uuroanoke>
2. From the upper right corner of the **Homepage**, click **Login**.
3. In the first logon field, enter your **Phone Number** (example: xxx-xxx-xxxx)
4. In the second field, enter the last four digits of your phone number as your **PIN**. The **Homepage** displays again.

Note If **Phone Number Not Found** displays, from the bottom of the screen, click the link **I'm new – Add me – Click here if you don't see your name listed** and follow the instructions for adding your contact information. Next, **call or email Lynn Yates** to be assigned a paddle (bidder) number (540.404.0812) or ljyates8@gmail.com.

5. Once you are logged on, from the top of the screen, click the **Catalog List** tab. All items available for bidding display. Scroll down to view all items.
6. To select an item to bid on, from the right-most column, click **Place Bid**.
7. From the next screen, enter **QTY** (number of items or seats), **Bid Price ea** (your opening bid), and optionally, a **Hidden Max Price ea** (the maximum you wish to pay).
8. Click **Save**.

If you use the **Max Price** feature, the software automatically increases your bid in increments until your maximum amount is reached.

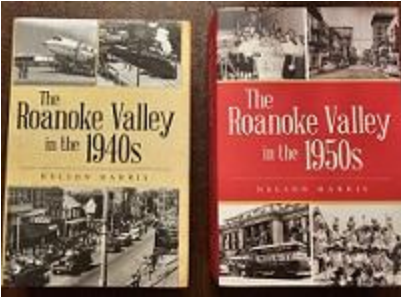

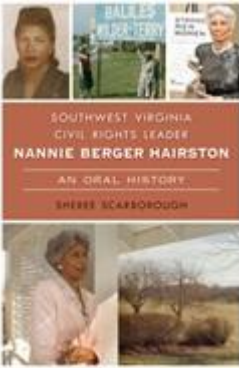
